IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The **Convention Program** will only be available online for you to download. You will be able to print either the whole program or just portions that you might like to take with you. You may be able to make notations on the program from your device if you have an appropriate program.
- **Convention Bling Transfers** are no longer available for purchase on the registration portal. There may be a very limited number available at the Sales Desk.
- There may be a very limited number of **Souvenir Convention Pins** available at convention at the Sales Desk.
- Registrations
 - Cancellation: Members can cancel their registration without penalty on or before 27 April 2023
 - Refund: 100% if cancelled by midnight on 26 April 2023
 - **Refund Application after 27 April 2023:** Any cancellations after the Cvent cut-off date are actioned by RMT Finance Coordinator, Annie Freeman. A refund request and an explanation is required to be submitted after which the RMT review for consideration.

Registration FAQs

Who can register for convention? Members and non-members can individually register and pay. They can also register at the same time for other people such as other chorus members, Sweet Adelines International members or non-members.

Can I modify or add to my registration after I have registered? Yes – in your registration confirmation email, you will receive a unique confirmation number that you can use to update or modify or add to your registration.

Do I have to complete the registration all in one go? No – you can start the registration process and then leave it for another day. All the information will be saved.

How is payment made? Only credit or debit card. Visa or Mastercard payments are accepted.

How does the Chorus Convention Liaison know who has registered for convention? A report will be sent every two weeks to all Chorus Liaisons, listing the names of the chorus members who have registered for convention. Extra reports can be requested from the Registration Secretariat at any time.

How are people able to register if they are not sent an invitation? They will be able to find the link to register on the Region 34 website.

How will people be able to get tickets to the competition sessions on Friday and Saturday? General public tickets will be available on the day using a QR Code at the Sales Desk at the venue or can be purchased via Trybooking on <u>https://www.trybooking.com/CHJLP</u>. YOUR JUDGES FOR 2023

Sound/Panel Chair – Mary Rhea

Mary is a member of the International Board of Directors, a Certified Sound Judge, a member of the Education Direction Committee, baritone of 2010 International Champion Quartet Zing! and Master Director of OK City Chorus. She served as cochair of the past two Directors' Seminars as well as being on Region 25's Education Steering Committee and as a past Regional Directors' Coordinator.

Music – Mary Ashford

Mary's early musical background included playing woodwind instruments while touring Europe with the 84th Army Band in Stuttgart, Germany.

Mary has been a member of Sweet Adelines since joining the Region 11 ChannelAire Chorus in 1996. Shortly after joining ChannelAire, she began codirecting the South Valley Sound Chorus for nearly a decade.

Mary sang with the Harborlites Chorus for several years and she sang bass with the International top ten quartet, Shimmer! Mary joined the judging program in 2010. She sings with the ChannelAire Chorus and is currently the Certified Master 600 Director of Carpe Diem Chorus. In 2017, Mary and the Carpe Diem Chorus won the Division A Harmony Classic.

Outside of Sweet Adelines, Mary and her wife, Lee, enjoy walks on their private beach, pickleball and their two adorable cats, Beanie and Samuel.

Expression – Patti Burklund

Patti Burklund has been a member of Sweet Adelines since 1976. She is a former member of the Lakeside Chorus, former director of Sea Island Sound Chorus, former Associate Director of Pacific Sound Chorus and current member of Song of Seattle Chorus.

She has been an active quartet member, competing at the International level in four quartets: Crosstown Sounds, HeartBeat, Mojo and PrimeTime – having achieved two 6th Place medals. Her current quartet, PrimeTime, will be competing in Louisville Kentucky in 2023 in their 7th consecutive International competition.







Patti is retired from a career in public administration. She has been a member of the SAI Judging Program for 28 years and is looking forward to serving on the 2023 Panel for Region 34!

Aside from music, her interests include golf, strength training and travel.

Visual Communication – Anna Rosenberg

Anna teaches and coaches all aspects of Visual Communication and directing.

Barbershop came into her life after her father brought barbershop to Sweden in the late 1960's after hearing it in Minnesota. Anna's sister and mother sing with Rönninge Show Chorus, with her mother being one of the original chorus members, and this is where Anna started her journey into the barbershop world. She sang with them until meeting her husband Henrik and moving to Helsingborg.



Her husband Henry was an active member in the barbershop realm and the former President of SNOBS, the male barbershop organisation in Sweden. Sad to say their twin sons (age 16), though they have attended countless conventions, hate barbershop.

Anna is a Certified Visual Communication Judge, a Master Director 700 – Pearls of the Sound chorus (4th in the world 2022), an Assistant Director of mixed chorus Northern Stars and the Past Education Coordinator of Region #32 (Northern Lights Region).

She has sung lead in two mixed quartets, Tarzan & Jane, who won world gold in 2012, and The Hillbillys.

Notably, Anna is the first non-native English-speaking judge ever.

Parade of Champions

The Parade of Champions will start approximately ninety minutes after the conclusion of the Chorus Competition. We encourage performers to remain at the venue and in their contest gear for the Parade of Champions.

Parade of Champions Briefing

For quartets and choruses who are eligible to perform in the Parade of Champions, a representative from each quartet and the chorus director must attend the briefing, which will be held at the conclusion of the Chorus Competition in the Plaza Ballroom.

The draft line-up for the Parade of Champions is as follows:

5th Place Chorus – 1 song 5th Place Quartet – 1 song 4th Place Chorus – 1 song 4th Place Quartet – 1 song AA Winning Chorus* – 1 Song 3rd Place Chorus – 1 song 3rd Place Quartet – 1 song 2nd Place Chorus – 1 song 2nd Place Quartet – 1 song 1st Place Quartet – 2 songs 1st Place Chorus – 2 songs

* If the A or AA Winning Chorus places in the top five, they will sing in the slot determined by their top five placements.

Groups will be called from the audience at which time they are to muster backstage in preparation for their performance.

Optimising Vowels for Consistent Resonance – Vicki Dwyer

This class bridges the gap between speech habits and singing technique to understand. Voice science will be explained to show how vowels can be produced to maximise the acoustic resonance in the vocal tract. Participants will explore the phonetic qualities of their own voices to discriminate sounds that are created by vowel formants and how this can be applied to achieve consistent delivery of vowels with matched resonance.

When you hear the phrase 'Music Category', do you get chills up your spine? Are you haunted by the Circle of 5ths? Are you spooked when you hear a Tritone? Be afraid no more as you delve into what's brewing with the Music Category.

Choosing Music for Contest – Mary Ashford

Are you bewitched, bothered and bewildered at the thought of choosing contest music? Do you howl at the moon with having to sing last year's contest song yet again? Do you scream at the thought of taking a chance with an unfamiliar ballad? It is time to release those fears and plunge in for the recipe for the vessel with the pestle that has the musical brew that is true.

What is Forward Motion? – Mary Rhea

All songs need forward motion, but how do we get it? Understand different aspects of forward motion and use and apply concepts to achieve it.

Artistry vs Technique – Mary Rhea

Artistry or technique? Can we do one at the expense of the other? Do we need both? YES! They work hand in hand for a truly moving performance.

Directors' and Judges' Debrief – All Judges

A facilitated conversation between directors, REF and judges about competition and moving forward.

Quartet Masterclass – Patti Burklund

Open quartet coaching from randomly selected volunteer quartets.
